Four Biblical Words used for Church Leaders

Presbuteros – Elder – Provides spiritual discernment

Poimaino – Shepherd/Pastor – Provides spiritual wellbeing

Episkopos – Overseer/Bishop – Provides spiritual accountability

Hygoumenois – Leader – Provides spiritual direction

Pastor/Shepherd definition – Guides and directs his flock in all aspects of their <u>spiritual life</u>. His wisdom, authority and oversight are founded upon his <u>spiritual maturity</u> which provides the <u>spiritual discernment</u> necessary to protect, provide for and lead his flock into a closer relationship with the Lord.

- 1. Shepherds will diligently toil in the word among the flock.
 - a. The shepherd will <u>preach and live</u> the word for the Flock.
 - b. The shepherd will <u>bear and care</u> for the burdens of the Flock.

 - a. Shepherds will own the responsibility for the <u>directional decision</u> <u>making</u> of the church.
 - b. Shepherds will own the responsibility for the <u>spiritual and numerical</u> growth of the church.
- 3. Shepherds will confront and correct error in the church.
 - a. Shepherds will confront and correct <u>errant doctrinal beliefs and teachings</u> and those who peddle them in the church.
 - b. Shepherds will confront and correct those who are <u>morally rebellious</u>.
